

■ The birth of "Art Bible" - Bible and paintings

In April 2003, JBS published the "Art Bible." This is our first challenge in publishing the Scripture targeted mainly to non-Christians. Not only for reading the text, but also for visualizing Biblical scenes more easily, this Book has many paintings paired with famous stories quoted from the Biblical text. As of this month, more than 30,000 volumes were distributed and the Art Bible is still in great demand. This may be because, with the visual effects of the masterpieces, it enables the readers to understand the world of the Bible more vividly.

■ The Bible even more vivid "Panoramic Bible" - experiencing the world of the Bible



The success of the "Art Bible" suggested us many things. We heard many voices desiring to understand the Bible in a much deeper way. Hence in the most recent publication, the "Panoramic Bible," we decided to enlarge the size ($257 \text{mm} \sim 367 \text{mm}$) for increasing visual effects and to include the texts from all books of the Bible, as well as putting many study notes, explanations, chronological tables, genealogies, etc.

The efforts resulted in a balanced book with variety of information for "reading," "seeing" and "studying" the Bible. This epoch-making publication is designed to allow even the people who read the Bible for the first time, to easily experience the vastness and the depth of

the Bible.

■ The challenge for audio Bible

Japan Bible Society already distributes Audio Bible in cassettes and CD's. Last year, we developed "Bible Talk - New Testament." The entire New Testament recording is compressed and saved in a small egg-shaped devise (90g). It enables the listener to select each book, chapter, and even verses. It is powered by two AAA batteries and can be used anywhere. For example, it is convenient for people who cannot carry heavy books or for those who are unable to read, or for bed-ridden people.

Moreover, with digital sound data, it is possible to produce "Bible Talk" in any language. Now we are in the process of developing an Audio Bible in MP3 format that can be downloaded to portable audio players such as iPod(R).





■ The Study Bible

Some people say that "one reason why Christianity is slow to spread in Japan is due to the fact that Japanese people have no Christian background, cultural or historical, and are unfamiliar with the Bible and its culture."

JBS published the New Testament Study Bible with detailed explanation notes, to help non-Christians and people who are not accustomed to reading the Bible. We have included some explanation notes translated from the CEV Learning Bible published by the American Bible Society, adopting them to the New Interconfessional Translation.

Currently, we are trying to complete the Old Testament. We hope that this will be an answer for the Japanese people to understand the Bible and that it will revolutionize the Japanese consciousness of the Bible.

Bible Readathon

Interdenominational meeting to read through the Bible

The Bible Readathon is an event where we read through the Bible from beginning to end, In other words, from Genesis to Revelation. The entire reading takes about 100 hours. Usually two people as a pair read 1 chapter alternately for thirty minutes and change to another pair.

This year, 2 Bible Readathons were held at different cities in Japan and finished successfully: in the eastern region, at Christian Center Kobe Bible House (in Kobe, 09-13/05/05), and in the western region, at Chiba Bible Festa (in Chiba, 05-13/05/05). The participants, who came from various churches in the area, were greatly blessed and encouraged by each other from reading the Bible together in one place. JBS encourages "Reading through the Bible," to individuals, churches, and regions.



Producing the Sign Language Bible for the hearing-impaired is a hard work requiring tremendous costs and time. So much so, that no such work in the world has been accomplished so far. The attempt to produce it in Japan was undertaken by Japan Deaf Evangel Mission in 1986 and as of now, 9 volumes in 8 videos are completed. Since 2003, with the help of our donors, JBS supports this project by subsidizing about \$70,000 of the costs each year. Please pray for the production of this Bible.
